FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions carry the same authority as the ASR's.

Noise and scrutineering will take place at the Anglesey Circuit

Your start number is as per enclosed seeded entry list which has been compiled using information given by competitors and from other sources available to the organisers. No discussions regarding seeding will be entered into. Competition numbers will be for sale at noise testing and these must be affixed to vehicle along with any additional decals provided by the organisers prior to entering scrutineering.

Competitors will be required to display official rally plate and event sponsors logos on their vehicles in locations as directed by the organisers. This advertising material will be collected at Noise Test and must then be affixed before attending scrutineering - Note - you will not pass scrutineering without the advertising material affixed in the correct place on your car.

SCRUTINEERING & NOISE TEST

Your scrutineering times are as follows.

Saturday 29th February 2020. Cars 1-20 2.30pm, 21-40 3.30pm, 41-60 4.30pm, 61-75 5.30pm

Sunday 1st March -: Scrutineering- 7.00 am PROMPT!!! only if pre-arranged

SATURDAY Upon arrival you should proceed as directed by the marshals to Noise and Scrutineering

SEE ABOVE RE TIMING FOR SCRUTINEERING

SUNDAY Upon arrival you should proceed as directed by the marshals to Unload trailers, Noise and Scrutineering

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they are signed on at least 30 minutes before their due time at MTC 1

TRAILERS Trailers are not permitted in the paddock area and once competing car has been unloaded must be parked on the grass verges to the side of the paddock area.

ROUTE TO AND FROM THE VENUE

All competitors and service vehicles are required to follow the A55 trunk road to the junction with the A4080. Take the A4080 past Llanfaelog to the Gate House and turn right down the road to the circuit. Do not use the yellow roads which cross from the A55/A5 to the A4080 as this only causes PR problems. Please DRIVE SLOWLY AT ALL TIMES whilst using the access road from the A4080 to the circuit. Please obey all speed limits whilst travelling through villages en route to and from the circuit

PLEASE NOTE: - On Saturday you must NOT turn up to the venue before 2.00pm as access is not permitted prior to this time due to other activities taking place at the venue.

All trailers must be parked in the area designated, or as instructed by the marshals. Anyone staying on site overnight is reminded that all vehicles other than the rally car and service vehicle must be removed from the paddock area by 7.00 am on the morning of the event. Bonfires are not allowed on site. Any person found driving round the venue, unless permission has been given by the Clerk of Course, will be removed and any competing vehicle associated with that person disqualification from the competition. YOU HAVE BEEN WARNED.

SUNDAY SCRUTINEERING: ~ all places for Sunday scrutineering have been taken by people who requested them AS PER THE REGULATIONS POINT 7. PLEASE DO NOT RING UP ASKING FOR SUNDAY INCLUSION. IT IS FULL

AUXILIARLY LIGHTING (SPOT LIGHTS)

Due to the rally running 2 weeks earlier than in recent years there could be the possibility of later stages being run in failing daylight. Competitors wishing to use auxiliary lights must present their car at scrutineering with any intended auxiliary lights fitted with correct dipped beam function.

TYRE/BRAKE WARMING

The warming of tyres and/or brakes is strictly prohibited anywhere within the venue. This includes the paddock area and any roads within the venue. Anyone caught doing so will be disqualified from the event and reported to Motorsport UK.

MOTORISED SCOOTERS

The riding of motorised scooters is prohibited anywhere within the venue. This includes petrol and electric powered versions and any derivative i.e segways. Non-compliance will be penalised by disqualification from the event.

DRONES

The flying of drones is strictly forbidden. Non-compliance will result in disqualification from the event.

FIRE LANE

There is a fire lane in front of the garage doors on the paddock side which must remain clear at all times. Competitors who are using the garages must not park their service vehicle in this area.

VEHICLE PASSES

Each competing crew will only be allowed the competing car and one service vehicle in the paddock area during the event. The relevant pass with vehicle registration number must be displayed at all times. All other vehicles must be parked in the spectator parking area or where directed by marshals. Due to space restraints this will be actively policed and any vehicles not displaying a pass will be removed. Further penalties may be applied to associated competitors up to disqualification. All trailers must be parked in the designated area.

PADDOCK AREA

The paddock area has been resurfaced and therefore the circuit management are prohibiting the use of pegs or stakes which cause holes in the tarmac. Any incidents of damage to tarmac will incur a £100 fine per hole and the wrath of Annette. Please ensure all members of your service crew are aware of this.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

All competitors must attend the drivers briefing which will take place at 8.30 am on Sunday 1st 2020 March in the scrutineering building.

START TIMES

Competitors due times at MTC 1 will be displayed on the official notice board in Rally HQ

REFUELLING

All refuelling must take place in the official refuelling areas. Please allow sufficient time to carry this out during service periods

Addition to regulation 20.5 of this event SR's Refuelling Zone Procedure -

Competitors must collect their fuel cans and associated equipment from the refuel zone within 30 minutes of the last car finishing the last stage of the event. Failure to collect in this timeframe will result in the equipment being left unattended to which the event organisers, championships and their partners accept no liability.

FHR's

Competitors will be checked for correct fitment of FHR devices at MTC1 and at other times during the event by the scrutineers.

STAGE START PROCEDURE

Traffic Lights will be used to start the stages. Do not forget the RED FLAG System will be in operation on all stages. Please familiarise yourselves with regulation R24.4.5 and R25.6.4 of the 2020 Motorsport UK Blue Book.

STAGE FINISH/ REGROUP PROCEDURE

After successful completion of each special stage there will be a regroup control (RTC) where previous time card will be collected and next time card issued along with due time at next stage arrival control. The area between stage stop and regroup control is parc ferme.
