5. The programme of the event will be: - Scrutineering starts at 08:30hrs; Individual times for scrutineering will be notified in Final Instructions. Any competitor not signed on by 1000hrs may be excluded. Practicing starts at 09:45hrs Competitive timed runs may start immediately after the completion of practice at the discretion of the Organisers.

6. The length of the circuit is 550 yards and consists of smooth tarmacadam surface, with two left hand and two right hand bends connected by straights.

7. The entry list opens on publication of the regulations and closes finally on Monday 26th May 2025 the entry fee is £100 (including MSA insurance and per capita fee). All entries must be made online and accompanied by the appropriate fee

11. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the MSA Ltd. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.

Additional awards will also be presented thus: - ANY one make car or motor club furnishing 5 or more entries will be eligible for best of that club/make.

12. All competitors and drivers must hold and present a valid Competition License plus a valid Club Membership Card or Championship Registration Card (as appropriate).

13 ALL refuelling must take place over an impervious membrane

14. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event and electronically sent to all Competitors within 7 days. Additionally it is intended to provide live timing of the event via the internet using Time Team's website visit:: www.timeteamlivetiming.co.uk or scan the QR code below:

15. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5.1.2.

16. The event will consist of at least the classes described in the Technical Regulations contained in these Regulations.

17. Starting order will be determined by classes. Cars will start singly. The starting signal will be a green light.

Method of timing will be by automatic split beam apparatus. The finish line will be indicated by a white line and checkered boards at the side of the track.

18. Competitors will have the opportunity of two practice runs. Competitors will have the opportunity to walk the course prior to the first practice run under official control.

19. There will be a minimum of two and a maximum of twelve timed runs. Subject to weather and conditions.

20. Competitors will be identified with numbers which will NOT be provided by the organisers.

21. Shared vehicles are permitted as long as two entries for the same vehicle are submitted. No more than two entries per vehicle are permitted

22 Marking and penalties will be printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK general regulations, in addition ,all four wheels off the tarmac surface –no time will be recorded

All other General Regulations apply as written except for the following which are modified:- S9.2.3. A driver may not compete in more than two cars during the event

All cars competing in Hill climbs and Sprints must be presented for scrutineering with a valid MSA Competition Log Book or an MSA recognised vehicle identity document unless the car is currently licensed for use on the public highway and competing in the event in a road legal condition (S9.1.7). PLEASE REFER TO THE 2024 TECHNICAL REGULATIONSFOR THE EVENT, IN ADDITION TO THE CLASSES LISTED IN THE TECHNICAL REGULATIONS ACCEPTED CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES WILL ALSOBE INCLUDED

There is no on line scrutineering, however on line signing on is required and licences will be checked on the day.

You must be able to produce a current UK Road Tax Insurance and MOT certificate, (where applicable), at the event in one of the **STANDARD** or **ROAD CAR** classes. Proof of road tax will be by DVLA Confirmation of Vehicle tax or a recent copy of the DVLA enquiry website :- <u>www.vehicleenquiry.service.gov.uk</u> Cars in the Standard Car Classes must use tyres from the List 1A in the current Motorsport UK NCR, all other Road Car Classes must use tyres from List 1A or1B,All tyres must comply with NCR Ch.8.4 (GR L2.3)

The forced induction equivalence for the Standard Car Classes is 1.7, for all other classes it is 1.4 – NCR 14.4.4.1 (GR S10.4.1

For rotary engines see NCR 14.4.4.2 (GR S10.4.2)

All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations and with the specific regulations for each category/class as specified inNCR 14 (GR S10) .

The requirements of the current Motorsport UK regulations with regard to safety provisions for Sprint and Hillclimb Cars must be adhered to ,including the use of suitable Frontal Head Restraints where mandatory

Clarifications for Road-going Series Production Cars

All cars must have current UK road tax. Proof will be via DVLA Confirmation of Vehicle Tax or a recent copy of the DVLA enquiry website (<u>www.vehicleenquiry.service.gov.uk/</u>), a current MOT if age requires it, & insurance. It is the driver's responsibility to prove compliance.

Standard Car Classes ~ Standard Cars conforming to NCR 14.4.13 (GR S11)

These classes are intended to provide low budget competition for newcomers to the sport or those with limited funds. Other than adding FIA/Motorsport UK approved/homologated safety equipment and/or fitting uprated brake friction material, no other modifications are allowed. Any replacement component fitted must be a *Standard Part or a Standard Pattern Part.

Restricted to 2-wheel drive cars produced since 1st Jan 2000, minimum production 5000 per annum.

Engine: Maximum capacity 2000cc (1400cc for Junior drivers), forced induction equivalency is 1.7.

Junior drivers must also comply with NCR 14.2.1.9 to 11 (GR S7.1.9).

Wheels and tyres: Standard wheels, and list 1A tyres only, complying with NCR 14.13.4 (GR S11.4)

Standard mHEV's (as defined in NCR 7.11 (GR J5.22.1 & J5.23.7)) with all electrical equipment operating at less than 60vDC or 30vAC may enter the Standard Car classes, subject to the 1.7 forced induction equivalency where applicable.

* "Standard" means a component that was listed in the car manufacturer's price list for that model of car

Classes 1A to 1G and 2A to 2D - Road Cars conforming to NCR 14.4.14 (GR S12)

Tyres: Tyres must be from List 1A or 1B complying with NCR 14.4.14.6 (GR S12.6).

Brakes: Brake callipers, discs, master cylinder, shoes & pads can be modified. Non-ferrous discs are only permitted in accordance with NCR 7.2.10 (GR J5.6.2). Modification of the brake pedal is permitted. The fitting of aftermarket pedal assemblies is not permitted. Anti-Lock braking systems can be removed but cannot be added to a vehicle that does not have one as a manufacturer specified option.

Suspension: Must comply with NCR 14.4.14.7 (GR S12.7). Strut Braces across the top of the front suspension turrets are allowed but these must be removable and not welded in place.

Safety: Pyrotechnic safety devices such as airbags and seatbelt pre-tensioners may be disconnected or removed.

Cars competing in road legal condition

Please Note: Scrutineers and Championship Officials reserve the right to check all road-going competition vehicles' taxation status via the DVLA website to ensure compliance with championship regulations. Class 5B : Formula Ford 1600 Racing Cars : Manufactured before 1st January 1994

Only full sets of the following tyres are to be used :-

Cars manufactured before 31.12.1971 :- Cooper/Avon Formula Ford specification ACB9 or Dunlop historic Formula Ford Tyres Cars manufactured 1.11972 to 31.12.1993:- Cooper/Avon Formula Ford specification ACB9 or ACB10 Tyres. All roadgoing cars must remain in a totally road-legal condition at all times. (S10.11.)

Classes 6 & 7: Classic Cars and Rally Cars.

All cars must comply with NCR 14 (GR Section S). Where there is conflict between regulations, those in NCR 14 (GR Section S) will apply.

All other Technical regulations are as specified in Section S
